Installation Instructions

1. Lay the mirror face down on a padded surface.
2. The back of the mirror must be absolutely clean, dry and grease free.
3. Peel off the protection paper approximately 4" and fold the paper back. Stick the mirror defogger directly onto the back of the mirror. Use towel or other soft material to press the back of the defogger, as you pull off the rest of the protective paper. Be careful not to leave air-bubbles between the mirror and defogger.



Electrical Connection

- Connect the wires of the defogger according to local regulations. (This may require a GFI circuit.)
- The power supply cable may be connected to the vanity lighting switch circuit. The mirror defogger should be switched. It is recommended mirror defoggers be switched with bathroom lights to turn on and off with the lights.
- Fix the mirror onto the wall with silicone or clips, then apply silicon again to seal around the edge of the mirror.
- Switch the power on and test the mirror. In approximately 3-5 minutes the mirror should become warm.

Warning

1. This defogger is to be used as a bathroom mirror defogger only, and should be installed in accordance with these instructions.
2. Installation is not difficult and conforms to standard industry practice. As with any electrical product, we do recommend installation be performed by a qualified person, in accordance with local building and electrical codes. Disconnect power at the breaker panel before installation.
3. Handle with care: Do not cut, puncture or use staples or nails to mount.
4. The heating element of the mirror defogger should never be cut or damaged. This will render the product useless and cannot be repaired. Take particular care not to damage the element, although excess material can be trimmed as long as the actual heating element is not touched.
